

Solar Hot Water – Lowest Cost Ever

For Regional Victorians (where there is no natural gas)

The Victorian Government is making good on its promise to reduce greenhouse gas emission, by introducing a new Solar Hot Water Rebate Scheme, effective from 14th June 2008.

What are the benefits of Solar Heat-pump Hot water?

Hot water accounts for 20% of a households greenhouse gas emissions in Victoria. By installing our 327-SS solar heat-pump you will reduce these emissions and also reduce your water heating costs.

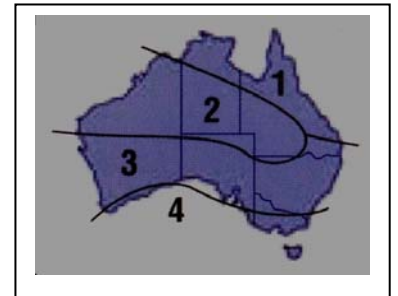
What is the value of RECs rebate?

The number of RECs assigned to each individual HWS is based on the solar contribution. The monetary value of the RECs rebate is calculated by multiplying the number of Renewable Energy Certificates by the current market price of each REC. The current value is \$49/REC (July 2008).

What is the value of the new Victoria Solar Hot Water Rebate Program?

The new rebate is also calculated on the solar contribution of the system. The 264-SS system carries the highest possible rebate of \$2500, the 327-SS system carries a rebate of \$2300.

Who is eligible for the new rebate?

From 14th June 2008, if you replace an electric water heater with a 264-SS or 327-SS heat-pump system from Skyline Energy, in a non-reticulated gas area, in regional Victoria only, you may qualify for the new \$2500 rebate, in addition to the RECs rebate.

The new rebate applies to:

1. A dwelling which does not have access to natural gas
2. A dwelling which is permanently occupied by an owner occupier.
3. A dwelling which is permanently occupied by a tenant. Landlords can access the rebate where there is a permanent tenant, and that tenant is responsible for the energy bills.
4. Must be replacing an existing electric hot water service

Is the new rebate available in Metropolitan Melbourne?

No. There is a separate Metropolitan Melbourne Solar Hot Water Rebate with similar conditions, and a maximum of \$1000 available.

Applying for the rebate:

1. You apply for the rebate as a point of sale discount.
2. Nominate a licensed plumber for installation
3. Complete, sign, witness, and return the Applicant Form
4. Get the plumber to issue a certificate of compliance, complete, sign and return the Installers Report.
